PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

I am a UK-based Consultant Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgeon practising within a large teaching hospital and major trauma unit. I manage a high volume of complex acute orthopaedic trauma cases involving both upper and lower limbs alongside an established elective lower limb practice.

I have completed subspecialty fellowships in Foot and Ankle Surgery, Trauma Surgery, Arthroplasty, and Paediatric Orthopaedics. This advanced training has provided extensive expertise in the management of complex fractures, ligamentous injury, post-traumatic reconstruction, joint preservation, deformity correction and primary and revision arthroplasty.

My clinical practice encompasses a full spectrum of trauma care, and I routinely manage high-energy trauma, periarticular fractures, complex soft tissue injuries, post-traumatic complications and degenerative joint conditions. I also undertake elective foot and ankle reconstruction and lower limb arthroplasty. MEDICOLEGAL PRACTICE

I prepare approximately 800–1000 medico-legal reports per year. I undertake around 20 orthopaedic negligence reports annually. My work comprises approximately 75% Claimant and 25% Defendant instructions.

Where required, I also provide addendum opinions, re-examination reporting, joint discussions and Part 35 responses in support of the above instructions.

Areas of Instruction:

I am instructed in cases arising from road traffic accidents, workplace and industrial accidents, public liability claims, slips and trips, and low-velocity impact injuries.

These matters include upper and lower limb trauma, spinal and pelvic injuries, paediatric trauma, and complex lower limb orthopaedic trauma.

My trauma expertise covers both upper and lower limb injuries. My elective orthopaedic practice is focused exclusively on the lower limb.
