SUMMARY OF SURGICAL EXPERIENCE

I have practiced as a Consultant Plastic, Burns & Reconstructive Surgeon at Nottingham University Hospitals NHS Trust since October 2019. I qualified from Leeds Medical School and undertook Basic Surgical Training in Yorkshire before concentrating on a career in Plastic Surgery.

The majority of my Higher Surgical Training has been performed in Specialist Advisory Committee-approved posts within the East Midlands and North Deaneries. I became a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons in Plastic Surgery (FRCS Plast) in 2014. Subsequently, I went on to complete a number of fellowships (2015-2018) in Microsurgery, Lower Limb Reconstruction and Aesthetic Surgery in the United Kingdom and Australia, respectively.

I was added to the General Medical Council (GMC) Specialist Register in April 2024.

My primary service commitments focus on lower limb trauma and reconstruction, with a particular emphasis on microsurgery. I manage both adult and paediatric burns and have sub-specialty interests in perineal, complex wound, and abdominal wall reconstruction. I also operate on paediatric patients requiring elective, trauma-related, or burns-related surgery. In addition, I am actively involved in scar management and run joint clinics with occupational therapists.

SUMMARY OF SERVICE DEVELOPMENT AND LEADERSHIP

I have led several service improvement initiatives, primarily in trauma and burns care:

- Developed and implemented a post-operative protocol for free flap surgery in lower limb trauma, now a standard document at the Trust.
- Created intranet guidance on using dermal substitutes such as Epiprotect® and BTM in burns and trauma care.
- Co-authored patient information leaflets on burn injury awareness, prevention, and surgical options for lower limb reconstruction.
- In collaboration with orthopaedics, have developed guidance and pathways for referring hospitals in the management of acute open fractures through the East Midlands Major Trauma Network.

Additionally, I played a key role in establishing the complex wound service at Nottingham University Hospitals NHS Trust. As a founding member, I was involved in recruiting a multidisciplinary team, developing a business case for funding, and co-authoring management guidelines. I chair the multidisciplinary team (MDT) meetings once a month, ensuring comprehensive care plans for complex wound patients.
